Release Notes

The following list includes new features and fixes changed since the last release of PRTK 6.3.2 and DNA 3.3.2 and 3.3.3.

PRTK 6.3.2 and DNA 3.3.2 Changes

The following changes have been made with the release of PRTK 6.3.2 and DNA 3.3.2, shipped with AccessData Forensic Toolkit[®] (FTK[®]) 2.0.

CodeMeter CmStick Support

The CodeMeter^{*} CmStick^{*} is supported allowing the use of the CmStick shipped with FTK 2.0. The CmStick replaces the Keylok^{*} green dongle for software security compliance. Both the green dongle and the CmStick are supported by this and future releases of DNA and PRTK releases.

Communication Layer Worker Improvement

The communication layer worker has been improved allowing more effective processing across a DNA cluster.

PRTK 6.3.3 and DNA 3.3.3

The following improvements have been made since DNA 3.3.2.

Dictionary Utility

Dictionary Utility now completely processes files that contain blank lines.

Linux Worker

Linux workers now process data.

Worker Update

When the Worker update is run, the Windows Worker updates.

Protected Registry Files

Internet Explorer* 7 Auto Complete password is now able to be processed.
